

# Insufficient Evidence



## **Appeal to Authority**

Arguer cites an unreliable authority or witness



## Appeal to Ignorance/Burden of Proof

Arguer claims that something is true because no one has proven it false or vice versa



#### **Appeal to Emotion**

Arguer manipulates an emotional response in place of a valid argument



#### **Loaded Question**

Arguer asks a question that contains an unfair or unwarranted assumption



## **Questionable/False Cause**

Arguer claims, without adequate evidence, that one thing is the cause of something else



## **Slippery Slope**

Arguer claims, without adequate evidence, that a seemingly harmless action will lead to a very bad outcome
